Enjoy wonderful freshly prepared food and good company. Relax in our lovely hand picked accommodation. Bedrooms are all based on twin and double rooms so everyone can enjoy their own space and privacy. *So come and join Clearwater Paddling and enjoy the sense of freedom and the spirit of discovery – it's more than just a holiday!*

Our trips are geared to anyone who is reasonably fit and in good health. We feel that a positive attitude and spirit of adventure are far more important than being in super shape. Although sunshine and warm breezes are always preferred, the ability to laugh in the face of wind and rain is mandatory.

Every day will be a mix of relaxation and adventure. On a good day we may spend four or five hours in the kayaks and cover between 7 to 10 miles, with plenty of opportunities to land, and explore the islands by foot. The aim of the trip is not an endurance test, but an opportunity to discover beautiful places using the ideal transport. For some it is the new activity that is appealing, whilst for others it's the peace and tranquillity.

Our kayaks are comfortable, roomy, stable and designed to remain upright. Our aim is for you to have an enjoyable and relaxing experience: not a cold wet one. We will not be making you capsize unless you want to! At the start of the first day, before we head off, you will be given instructions on the basic paddling skills, and safety. Within minutes you will feel comfortable and confident, in control of your kayak. You will quickly discover there is nothing fancy to paddling your kayak, and over the week you will refine your skills and soon feel like a seasoned paddler.

We are more than happy to take people on our *Lodge* and *Wild Camping* tours who have never kayaked before. However we do suggest that is well worth trying it for even an hour or two just to get a feel of it before you come on one of our trips. We would also suggest visiting this website <http://www.monkeysee.com/play/454-kayak-fundamentals>, which will give an idea of what to expect.

Your safety and enjoyment is our priority, and we never, ever, 'risk it!' Guides are equipped with all necessary equipment including first aid kits, tow ropes, flares, and VHF radios. We hold current First Aid certificates and guides are qualified instructors certified by the British Canoe Union.

### **Food glorious food**

Food is an essential ingredient in any successful trip and we take great pride in our delicious high quality food. Each morning there is a cooked breakfast, after which we make up packed lunches. When we return from a day out kayaking there will be afternoon tea and freshly baked cakes waiting for us. On all our Barra based trips we have a local cook who produces wonderful meals using local produce from her own croft and from the sea. Meals may include prawns, crab and freshly caught fish, Barra lamb and pork, and other such delights. The

standard of food we serve is perhaps the biggest surprise of the week for many people. Invariably it far exceeds expectations We are delighted to accommodate for vegetarian and other diets.

## **WE RUN THREE DIFFERENT KINDS OF TOUR TO SUIT ALL ABILITIES AND INTERESTS:**

### **1. Lodge based tours**

Our *Lodge* based tours allow you to enjoy your kayaking and mixing it with the best of comforts. Each day we will set off to explore these stunning islands. After a day of salt air and kayaking we will return to our warm, welcoming and comfortable accommodation where hot showers, wonderful food and comfortable beds are waiting. We offer a variety of paddling destinations in the Hebrides. These tours are suitable for all levels of paddling experience. We would particular recommend these trips to new paddlers.

### **2. Wild camping tours**

Imagine landing your kayak on a stunning beach on some distant island and setting up camp for the night. Imagine sitting round a driftwood fire as night draws in. You hear the call of distant seals and the excited chatter of oystercatchers. There is no better way of seeing wildlife than from the cockpit of a kayak, and no better time to see wildlife than early morning and late evening.

On all our camping trips we will travel as a self-sufficient group, carrying all our food and equipment with us, setting off to a new wild camp site each day. However being self-sufficient does not mean compromising on comfort. We load as much fresh food as possible, so at the end of the day there is always good food and a glass of wine and a dram to finish of a great day out.

These tours are suitable for all levels of paddling experience. Wild Barra is perhaps the most suited to people new to the sport, as it is half accommodation based and half camping based. Our 'Wild camping tours' are in more protected areas and are suitable for all levels of ability. It should be remembered when booking that all these tours are six nights\* *Wild Camping*.

### **3. Journeys**

Clearwater Paddling is proud to offer epic adventures, travelling through some of Scotland's wildest seascapes.

To get the most out of these stunning Wild Journeys tours paddlers should be happy kayaking in a larger swell and making longer crossings. The tours are suited to paddlers who have at least 10 days experience of sea kayaking in a variety of conditions. Like all our tours if the conditions are not safe, then we will not paddle.

### **LODGE BASED TOURS**

#### **The Magic of Barra / The Magic of Harris**

Lying on the very fringe of Europe the Outer Hebrides are amongst the most beautiful islands in the world. This string of islands offers fantastic scenery and wildlife, and make for a truly beautiful paddling destination. We offer two different locations on the islands; to the south lies Barra, (the most southerly inhabited island), while further north lies Harris. From our lodge bases we will explore surrounding islands to discover bays, quiet lagoons and stunning white beaches. As we slip quietly by in our kayaks we may catch a glimpse of dolphins and basking sharks. We will meet the island resident seals, otters, and a fantastic array of birds. Golden eagles can be spotted

soaring over the islands: guillemots, and razorbills nest on the high sheer cliffs, whilst oystercatchers and plovers can be seen picking amongst the mussels and limpets on the seashore.

We will also take time to explore the islands on foot, and climbing the hills gives breathtaking views over the Hebrides, towards Skye, Rum, and beyond. The flowers of the islands are truly beautiful. During spring primroses festoon the dunes, whilst in summer flowers carpet the machair. Today the islands are home to fishermen and crofters and retains a strong sense of community where Gaelic is widely spoken.

#### **The Magic of Moidart**

Based at Marino Lodge with stunning views over to Eigg and Rum this tour explores the Sound of Arisaig, Moidart and Ardnamurchan this wonderful tour really has something for everyone. In parts there are gorgeous white coral beaches and a myriad islands scattered across the sea. Paddling through these islands is like finding your way through a beautiful maze. Underneath you lie turquoise seas, surrounded by stunning views of the Inner Hebrides. In contrast you will find wild rocky coastlines punctured by small coves and caves. Then there are the more sheltered sea lochs where at last trees can begin to thrive. Here are stands of ancient Caledonian pines, and woodlands of oak, birch, beech and rowan, with the long abandoned Castle Tioram in the background. Another fantastic trip is kayaking over Loch Shiel followed by a paddle down the beautiful wood flanked River Shiel into Loch Moidart.

#### **The Magic of Assynt**

This fantastic tour, which incorporates lovely lodge accommodation with paddling amidst a variety of coastlines and landscapes makes

this a kayaker's dream. The scenery here is unique and has been awarded geopark status for its extraordinary landscape, where the sandstone peaks of Suliven, Canisp, Quinag, Cul Mor, Cul Beag and Stac Polly stand in splendid isolation over the cnoc and lochan landscape.

Our kayak exploration will take us to the Summer Isles, where dolphins, porpoise and seals are regularly seen. We will travel along the rocky coast of Lochinver, past white sandy beaches, arches and caves and under the famous sea stack, the Old Man of Stoer. With the right conditions we may circumnavigate Handa Island, an exhilarating Scottish Wildlife Trust bird reserve. On the sheer sandstone cliffs nest some 180,000 including puffins, guillemots, razorbills, skuas, fulmars and kittiwakes.

### **The Magic of the Inner Hebrides**

Based south of Oban this tour allows for maximum flexibility to explore some of the fascinating Inner Hebrides Islands. Each day we will set out to paddle new areas. On a good day we could cross over to Jura to witness the world-renowned Corryvecken whirlpool, one of the biggest whirlpools in the world. Or head North of Scarpa and visit the Grey Dog. On another day we may circumnavigate Luing and Seil and paddle under the 'Bride over the Atlantic'. There is a great variety of scenery from the unmistakable Paps of Jura to the wooded sea lochs around Loch Melfort and Loch Craignish. The sea around the Inner Hebrides is particularly good for wildlife encounters, with seals, eagles and the possibility of seeing dolphins and even whales. With shelter lochs, a whole host of islands, big and small, whirlpools and much, much more this trip has it all .

## **WILD CAMPING TOURS**

### **Wild Barra**

Barra and the surrounding islands make for a stunning kayaking destination. Paddling and camping here is wonderful, where we can escape to places where others simply do not go. The scenery is breathtaking with hills that tumble down to the sea, and islands fringed with brilliant white sands in a clear turquoise sea.

Each day we will travel to camp in amazing places. It might be an island with a glorious beach on one day and a quiet lagoon on another. We will take time to explore rocky coves and inlets and allow curious seals to drift over to us. If we are lucky we may see basking sharks at close quarters and glimpse otters hunting along the shore.

### **Wild Uist**

Uist with its miles of unexplored rocky shoreline, and myriad islands is an adventure just waiting to happen. Based upon the Uists in the Outer Hebrides we will travel northwards up the wild, remote and majestic east coast. We will paddle in sea lochs, renowned for otter sightings and explore inlets and bays far from the beaten track. We will camp in quiet lagoons, on a glorious beach and on small islands surrounded by mountains and wildlife.

During our journey we will take time to climb some of the highest peaks in Uist, home to red deer and eagles. The terrain is rugged, but the effort is rewarded with absolutely stunning views. Below your feet lies the Uists a latticework of land and water, whilst further a field lie the islands of Barra, Skye, and Rum. The mix of hills and sea lochs, wild coastlines, quiet lagoons and white sandy beaches makes this an unforgettable and unique adventure.

## **Wild Moidart**

Wild Moidart is a spectacular journey through some of Scotland's most stunning scenery. We begin our journey on Loch Airlot, surrounded by the wild hills. From here we will travel towards Arisaig and the beautiful archipelago of tiny islands and skerries fringed by pure white coral sands, lying in clear turquoise waters. We then carry on along the wild windswept coasts and head into Loch Moidart. Scattered across this magnificent loch are islands that are covered in pine, birch, beech and oak woodlands. Our journey continues past Ardtoe and the 'Singing Sands', and out onto Ardnarmurchan's wild windswept coast.

## **Wild Rassay**

The circumnavigation of Rassay and Rona is one of the classic sea kayak journeys of the Inner Hebrides. Lying between Skye and Applecross, Rassay is ringed by the magnificent Cullins and Trotternish hills to the south and west, and the Applecross hills and Torridon Mountains to the east and north. Closer at hand Rassay has incredible cliffs, flanked with ancient woodlands, and tumbling waterfalls, which rise high above the passing paddler.

Each day we will continue our journey to set up camp in a new stunning location. On Rassay, Rona and the islands to the north stand long abandoned villages and shielings over looking quiet, protected bays, the perfect haunt for seals and otters. The high cliffs are home to eagles and deer, while the Inner Sound is an ideal area to see porpoise, dolphin, basking shark and even the occasional whale.

## **Wild Inner Hebrides**

The Inner Hebrides south of Oban offer some of the most diverse and flexible sea kayaking that Scotland has to offer. With both open seas

and more sheltered sea lochs this trip allows us to fully exploit the best and possibly worst of the Scottish weather. A classic trips is the crossing over to Jura to witness the world-renowned Corryvecken whirlpool, one of the biggest whirlpools in the world. Heading north of Scarpa lies the Grey Dog and the lovely group of islands known as the Garvellachs. Closer inshore lies the islands of Luing and Seil, where we can paddle under the 'Bride over the Atlantic'. All around is a great variety of scenery from the unmistakable Paps of Jura and views out to Mull and Colonsay to the wooded sea lochs around Loch Melfort, Loch Craignish and Loch Sween. With stronger tidal movement the seas around the Inner Hebrides are particularly good for wildlife encounters, with seals, otters, eagles and the possibility of seeing dolphins, basking sharks and even whales.

## **JOURNEYS**

### **Hebridean Journey 7 nights**

The aim of this tour is to explore the parts no other tours visit. Weather depending this wild camping journey will begin in Castlebay and travel to the furthest south islands in the Outer Hebrides, visiting Vatersay, Sandray, Pabby, Mingulay and Berneray. Following this we will head north along the rocky shoreline of Barra up into the Sound of Barra. (This tour visits very remote islands; therefore the itinerary is subject to the weather conditions).

We will have the opportunity to paddle amongst rafts of puffins, razorbills and guillemots, which nest each summer on these remote islands. See seals hauled out on the rocks, otters searching for food, and perhaps glimpse dolphins and basking sharks in the sounds. The awe-inspiring scenery dwarfs the paddler. Kayak below massive sheer

200m cliffs, and past caves, arches and huge stacks. This is some of the grandest and wildest wilderness imaginable.

### **Jura Journey 6 nights**

This trip will explore the incredible coastline of Jura, with the aim of a complete circumnavigation. Jura has it all, whirlpools, wild mountain scenery, rugged coasts, and its famous raised beaches. Standing proudly off the west coast of Scotland in the Inner Hebrides, Jura is both easily accessible, yet retains an almost mystic presence.

At its north end is the world-renowned Corryvecken whirlpool, one of the biggest whirlpools in the world. The roar of the tide rushing through the sound can be heard from several miles away. To witness this stunning sight from the shores of Jura is reason alone to make this journey. Passing through the sound (during slack water!) we paddle southwards down the west coast. Here lie the extraordinary raised beaches, which stand many metres above sea level. Towering above the beaches stands the Paps of Jura, a ridge of mountains, which rise steep and proud. Along the coast we will pass through quiet sea lochs, and camp amongst the wild, beautiful scenery.

### **Mull Journey 6 nights**

Mull has many world know features, Iona and the majestic abbey, Staffa and the incredible Fingal's Cave, and the remarkable Treshnish Islands to name but a few. On this trip we will explore the southwest corner of Mull (Ross of Mull) with beautiful secluded beaches, high rocky cliffs, and stunning views over the Inner Hebrides towards Tiree and Coll in the west and Jura and Islay to the south. We will take time to circumnavigate the beautiful little island of Iona, which has little coves, white beaches and great views of the Abbey. If conditions allow we will make the crossing over to the Treshnish islands and

Staffa with the opportunity to paddle right into Fingal's cave which is an unforgettable experience. The cave is formed from huge numbers of basalt columns. This feature carries on under the sea to end up at the Giant's Causeway in Ireland. On both Staffa and the Treshnish Islands puffins can be seen busily flying to and fro from their burrow nests, whilst the seas around these islands are one of the best places to see whales and dolphins.

### **Harris Journey 6 nights**

Lying at the northern end of the Outer Hebrides, the Isle of Harris is a stunningly beautiful island. With astonishingly white beaches backed by wild ragged hills Harris is truly remarkable. The aim of our tour is to circumnavigate Harris, whilst on the way visiting the islands of Taransay, Scarp, Scalpay and the Sound of Harris. Highlights include the caves that line the coast of Scarp, and the mountain backdrop to the sea lochs north of Huisinis. Then there is the wild rocky loch encrusted east coast of Harris, which leads on to the beautiful island studded Sound of Harris. Finally there is the beach fringed west coast and as one passes Toe Head the full glory of Harris opens up, with Tranasay, the beaches at Horgabost and Sellebost and the high mountains as a backdrop. Not a journey to be taken lightly, but one that will stay with you forever.

## **OVERSEAS TOURS**

### **Oman Exploration**

Oman has it all. Stunning mountain scenery, endless white beaches, a rich cultural heritage, warm, friendly people and diverse scenery and wildlife make it a unique destination for adventure travellers. It is home to over 400 species of birds, large colonies of nesting turtles

and even boasts its own population of breeding humpback whales. This tour includes some wonderful paddling mixed with the opportunity of exploring the high mountains and wadis. Daytime temperatures are around 25°C, which drops to around 18°C at night.

Our tour begins with a relaxing day to allow everyone to adjust to the climate. We will visit the Grand Mosque, the Sultan's Palace and the Muttrah souk. In the afternoon we will head down to the harbour to enjoy a trip out in a hand built wooden dhow for lunch and some swimming.

Our kayaking expedition will explore the wonderful coastline to the south of Muscat, where we will take time to explore the inlets and bays. At night we will be wild camping on white sandy beaches and as we travel on we will head to the rugged and beautiful fjords of Bander Al Khayran. With snorkelling kit to hand we can cool off while observing the teeming marine life in Oman's waters. Taking a break from the water we will head into the cooler temperature of Oman's Hajar mountains at over 2000m, where we will discover the beautiful wadis and mountain ranges on stunning walks before making a wild camp for the night. Enjoy the breathtaking views of Oman's Grand Canyon and Nakhr village over 1km below, and follow a balcony trail along the mountain edge to an abandoned village, which clings to the rocks completely hidden from view..

### **Sardinia Exploration**

We so enjoyed our first visit this year that we are going back again in 2010! The tour will be in La Maddalena National Park, a stunningly beautiful archipelago lying between Sardinia and the southern tip of Corsica. In the summer it is buzzing with boats of all types. By the end of September the summer holidaymakers are gone and the islands return to their own quiet ways.

This is sea-kayaking heaven with dozens of islands to explore, deserted bays and rugged coastlines. Paddle pass some of the most amazing rock formations, eagles, trolls, fish, bears, hollow rocks, puffins and parrots, orcs to name a few. Add to this is the temptation of paddling in warm crystal clear Mediterranean waters and sunshine!

The aim of the trip is run a self contained trip exploring the islands and camping on deserted beaches for five nights. Like all our tours the weather will play its part, but with so many islands scattered in close proximity there is plenty of sheltered paddling to be done. The trip is 5 nights camping with a final night in accommodation at the end of the trip. This tour is suited to people who enjoy the sense of adventure that comes with exploring new areas. The paddling will be a mix of sheltered waters with the opportunity of rounding more exposed headlands. Feel free to contact us if you would like more details.

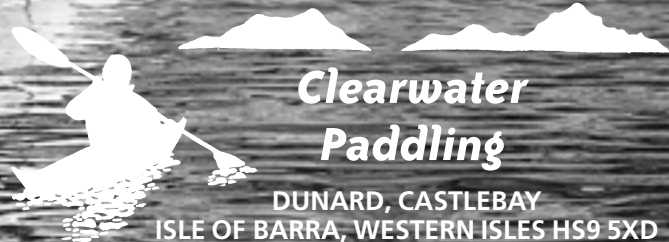
